The Country Doctor Museum

The Country Doctor Museum is the oldest museum in the United States dedicated to the history of America's rural health care. It was created in 1967 by a group of energetic women from North Carolina, whose initial interest was to build a lasting memorial for rural physicians. Over the decades, the Museum's collection grew to over 5,000 medical artifacts and many volumes of historic texts gathered from across the nation. The interpretive range also expanded from rural doctors to include topics such as nursing, pharmaceuticals, and home remedies.

In 2001, the Country Doctor Museum's board of directors decided to seek new stewardship. With its focus on primary care medicine, the division of Health Sciences at East Carolina University seemed to be an appropriate guardian. After two years of negotiations, the Museum was donated to the Medical Foundation of East Carolina University. Through an agreement with the Foundation, the Museum is managed today as part of East Carolina University's Laupus Health Sciences Library.

The Museum invites people of all ages to visit and learn about the history of rural health care in the United States. Docents lead tours through three buildings of exhibits and are available to answer questions. Exhibits contain artifacts

relevant to the practice of medicine between the late 18th century and the first half of the 20th century.



However, the Downtown foot print includes; The Rocky Mount Mills, with its restaurants, breweries, and River and Twine hotel, The Farmers Market, The Bel Air Art Center, The Booker T Theater, the Howard Street Arts District, the Douglas Block, Five Points, and Station Square districts with their unique shops and eateries.

Station Square

Located next door to the historic Helen P. Gay Train Station, the vibrant Station Square has truly been a staple in downtown Rocky Mount. Occupying an entire city block, Station Square carries on its well-known legacy of being a center for business and organizations of all sizes, the more notable being their coffee & wine bars.


brought six buildings back to life in the

historic African-American business district, is another success. This area has added a variety of businesses to this vibrant area of Downtown. They are well known for their unique shops & eateries. In addition to this businesses, residential apartments have been added, which brought vitality back to this area.

Five Points Intersection

Landmarked by the Rocky Mount Campus of Edgecombe Community College, the Five Points intersection has been a growing downtown hot spot for local eateries and small businesses. Across the street from the ECC campus sits the historic 1904 May & Gorham Building, soon to be renovated by a local developer. The notorious intersection is located where Rose Street, Tarboro Street, and Washington Street all meet, is within walking distance of the Douglas Block, and is about a half a mile away from Station Square.







Helen P. Gay Rocky Mount **Historic Train Station**

The train station was constructed in 1893 by the Wilmington & Weldon Railroad. It was a two-story brick Romanesque station with one story wings.

In 1911-1912 the new owner Atlantic Coastline Railroad turned the one story wings into threestory wings.

In 1977 the train station underwent another renovation adding the new entryway allowing passengers to enter the station from the street. A commons park was built in the front yard of the train station, as well as parking and streetscaping. The latest rennovation began in 1997 and was completed in 2000.

Today, the AMTRAK Station runs daily. It is served by four passengers trains.

Battle Park

Battle Park is site to Rocky Mount's first post office and theatre, as well as the "rocky mounds" where Rocky Mount got its name. In 1863, Battle Park served as the setting for a civil war battle that resulted when the Union Army destroyed textiles and farms all along the Tar River. Today it is currently home to one of the largest wooden suspension bridges in the USA.

The natural resource-based, recreation park serves as the central hub for the Tar River Trail and Tar River Paddle Trail. The park offers a boat landing, 3 picnic shelters, fishing piers, and a gazebo with a view of the Rocky Mount Mills dam. Battle Park is a favorite among local fishermen for the spring run of American and hickory shad, as well as striped bass. All federal and state fish and game laws apply.





CITY TRAIL SYSTEM

Near the center of Rocky Mount the Parks & Recreation Department oversees a system of parks, trails, and arts and recreational facilities. The 3.1 mile Tar River Trail runs along its namesake river from Sunset Park in the west to Martin Luther King, Jr. Park in the east. In between, the trail passes through several city landmarks, including Battle Park. To the north of the river near the junction of US Highway 64 and N. Church Street is the Rocky Mount Sports Complex and Athletic Stadium. South of the river on Church Street is the Imperial Centre for the Arts & Sciences and the Veterans Memorial at Jack Laughery Park.



acre park is located on Falls Road and the Tar River. Rocky Mount's first post office, theatre and the "rocky mounds" where Rocky Mount got its name, are located in the confines of the park. The park has a greenway, a boat landing, 3 picnic shelters, an overlook.
